

THE BANNED ITEMS LIST 2024

Some novelty items are considered unsuitable for sale. Anything that can be used to create injury or nuisance to animals or people is banned from sale. A list of unsuitable and banned items is available on our website.

The list largely supports the Agricultural Shows Banned Items List.

We have agreed that the following items are banned from sale or display at the Diamond Creek Rotary Town Fair:

- Pop downs (throw downs), 8 Shot Caps, Strip Caps, Roll Caps. All Caps are banned.
- Fireworks - Crackers – Explosive items of any description are banned.
- Knives of any description.
- Toy guns (for sale or given as prizes) are NOT acceptable in any form.
- Samurai Swords, English Swords and Fencing Swords are to be sold in sealed Packages by Licensed Traders ONLY.
- Water pistols (for sale or given as prizes) are NOT acceptable in any form. Water bombs are not permitted.
- Explicit & Hardcore T-Shirts, Explicit DVD's & videos, Fake Cigarettes, Fuel Type Fire Lighters (Zippos), Iridescent hair spray, Horns and Trumpets, Metal and Wooden martial art nunchuckers, Playing Cards (Nude or Lewd), Pressure Pack items–Gas (all types), Snow, Silly String, Drug Related Goods (incl. Cocaine Kits and Bongs etc.), Stink Bombs, Laser Pointers, pen lights, Torches etc., Bouncing Beans.
- ANYTHING THAT CAN BE USED TO CREATE INJURY OR NUISANCE TO PEOPLE OR ANIMALS IS BANNED.

Per-Approval Pics

Any item you think is legal to sell but may prove to be controversial (e.g. toy guns, swords, bow & arrows etc), should have pics submitted to our committee for pre-approval. If you do not, you risk being instructed to remove those items from sale. In extreme cases, you risk having your stall closed on the spot and without refund. Requests for Pre-Approval should be sent to rcdctownfair@gmail.com.

Please Note: It is the Site holder's responsibility to ensure they are compliant with the laws regarding the sale of Novelty Items, including the Dangerous Goods (Explosives) Regulations 2000, Regulation 803 and the Dangerous Goods Act 1985-554, so that an illegal item is not sold at the Show. Banned or illegal items will be confiscated and the names of the Site holders found selling banned items will be circulated to the police and other fair and ag show organizers.

Also:

- **Single Use Plastic Bags** are prohibited by State Government regulation which came into force late 2019.
- **Balloons** are not permitted as many of them end up in our waterways and being ingested by wildlife.
